SHOW HUNTERS

For horses that show a little more substance than is required for show hack classes. They should be quality animals and demonstrate the same ability to provide a smooth even ride and a reliable temperament. Movement should be bold and should cover the ground with a gallop well balanced moving from shoulder with the hind legs well under – a certain amount of knee action is permissible. A flat stilted action is unacceptable.

Manners are extremely important and misdemeanours should be penalised. Saddlery should be clean and neat, browband plain, not ribboned, saddle may have a more forward cut. Riders should preferably wear a tweed jacket and the workout should be similar to show classes but must include a gallop.

54. "Good Hands" Qualifying Riding Competition for girls 12 years and under 15 on the day of the Show. *(Same conditions as for boys).*

55. Leading Rein Pony, n.e. 12hh to be ridden by child 3 years and under 8 years. *The pony is led, with the lead fixed to the back of the cavesson nose band. Long whip and spurs and bit other than a snaffle is NOT allowed. Pony is judged on manners, quality, movement, obedience and general suitability as a leading rein pony. It may be required to walk and trot, but not to canter, and stand while the rider dismounts and is legged up. The pony is to be judged not the rider.*
